CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

FARMOZ CAVALRY 720 SC FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing 720 g/L CHLOROTHALONIL as their only active constituent.

SIPCAM ECHO 900 WDG FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing 900 g/kg CHLOROTHALONIL as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
EGGPLANT	GREY MOULD (<i>Botrytis cinerea</i>)	Products containing 920 g/kg chlorothalonil: Apply 80g/100L Products containing 720 g/L chlorothalonil: Apply 100mL/100L

Critical Use Comments:

- Do NOT mix spraying oils or wetting agents with these products.
- Apply chlorothalonil as part of an overall resistance management program in rotation with fungicides from other chemical groups.
- Apply when environmental conditions conducive to disease are present.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 7 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

GENERAL

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.
