## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

ACROBAT FUNGICIDE

Plus other registered products containing 500 g/kg dimethomorph as their only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
SILVERBEET ( <i>Beta vulgaris</i> )	DOWNY MILDEW ( <i>Peronospora</i> spp.)	360 g/ha of Acrobat plus mancozeb at registered rates (refer to the approved label).

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply two consecutive sprays, 7 to 10 days apart when conditions favour the disease but before the disease becomes evident.

### Withholding Period:

**DO NOT HARVEST FOR 14 DAYS AFTER LAST APPLICATION**

### Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, NT, and WA.

(Note: Vic is not included in this permit as that State's control of use legislation does not require a permit to be issued to cover this use.)

### Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

To avoid crop damage:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.

Export of Produce:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
